10 Effective Ways to Help Elect God-Fearing Leaders & Assure Fair Elections

1 Pray for our leaders and nation (1 Tim. 2;1-4, 2 Chron. 7:13-14)

- a. Join a network or form a prayer group
- b. Sign up to be a PJI Prayer Warrior

2 Learn and share Biblical principles of good government (Psalm 111:4)

Remembering the wonderful works of God (including America's Biblical foundation) causes us to Him more, and know how to protect America's Biblical foundation and liberty.

3 Register and encourage others to register and vote for the most Biblically-aligned candidates (Exod. 18:21)

Lead and guide your brothers and sisters in fulfilling our Biblical duty to elect God-fearing leaders (which begins with voter registration). With the Pastor's permission, you can conduct **non-partisan voter registration** at church, and share **non-partisan voter registration guides.**

4 Encourage and positively influence independent and undecided conservative voters. (Proverbs 9:9)

Learn user-friendly, direct voter contact technology and **encourage** others to vote for the most Biblically-aligned candidates. *Encourage others to do the same!*

5 Use and help create non-partisan voter guides. (Proverbs 4:11)

Equip Judeo-Christians to vote Biblically by analyzing contribution and endorsement data as part of a team to assign grades to the candidates, so voters can quickly discern which candidates are most Biblical.

7 Serve as a poll monitor or worker to assure fair Elections.(Colossians 3:23)

Help ensure that every lawfully cast vote is accurately counted in each Election!

8 Watch/read informative, encouraging, conservative news. (1 Chron. 12:32)

Like the men of Issachar, *know the times* (current events) for **prayer** and **action** in support of Biblical principles (e.g. pro-life, pro-marriage, religious liberty, etc.)
